When the Session of Apostle learned what Shared Journeys charter school was all about, we took the opportunity to hold a very successful rummage sale on their behalf. It also made the session think about how we could help them by providing a much larger school space for them, also providing an Infant Lab (child care), which they currently do not have. The kids in the charter school all have a child. Currently that child is with the student all the time. There is no child care (Infant Lab) provided to the students where they are currently located. It is hard to study with a child in your lap. Yet these kids have a 100% graduation rate!

Shared Journeys is a charter school within the West Allis-West Milwaukee School District whose mission statement is "To provide expectant and school-aged parents an opportunity to complete a high school education, encouraging strong parenting, healthy lifestyles and building post-secondary skills through a supportive community and innovative learning environment." The Dean of Students and lead teacher is Lisa Colla. Currently, the program is located in the lower level of a building at 9004 West Lincoln, in a space that is donated by Aurora Medical Center.

Pastor Cathy Manthei has a strong connection to Shared Journeys and she will be happy to tell you her very personal story as to why she is very involved at Shared Journeys.

Shared Journeys has 100% student graduation rate. The students also enjoy a 95% average daily attendance rate, which is much above the district average. Another key piece for Shared Journeys is the poverty rate. While the median household income for the State of Wisconsin is \$52,738, the median income for West Allis is \$44,475. It is estimated that between 14-16% of our student population are homeless. Can you imagine being a teenager, having a baby and being homeless?

The school district provides the salary for Mrs. Colla but that is all. The rest of the program comes from generous private support as well as many community partners. Aurora Health Systems pays their rent.
