Presenter Dr. Sarah Drummond is an ordained minister of the United Church of Christ. She is an associate dean and assistant professor at Andover Newton Theological School and an affiliated minister at Memorial Church at Harvard University. She is the author of Holy Clarity: The Practice of Planning and Evaluation, a book that offers a model for congregational evaluation as a practice of faith. Sarah was formerly the campus minister of the University Christian Ministries located on the UW-M campus.

Some Highlights from her book:

Sarah says ‘that Leadership and Evaluation are not separate disciplines. Evaluative activities are part of the work of a leader.’

An experienced evaluator spends less time posing ‘process questions’ such as “Did you enjoy the worship service?” and more time on questions about outcomes, such as “How is your faith changing since you began attending this church?”

‘The pastor in a faith community adapting to postmodernism must behave more like a sheepdog than a shepherd.’

‘Leaders need to know what is happening in their organizations and how those activities are effecting change. Evaluation exists to serve that need, and its best practices are shaped by a desire to learn.’
