





Presbytery of Milwaukee Pulpit Supply List

The following people have been cleared by the Commission on Ministry to preach in churches of the Presbytery of Milwaukee when invited by the pastor with the concurrence of session or by the session in the absence of a pastor. The pastor or session seeking pulpit supply should make contact directly with the individual on the list.

Presbytery of Milwaukee's recommended honorarium for a pulpit supply is \$150 for one service and \$200 for two services. Congregations should discuss ahead of time with the pulpit supply additional compensation for non-traditional technological services, such as recording or editing or online worship. In addition, the cost of travel at the current IRS rate of .575 cents/mile is recommended. (See KEY at the bottom for description of electronic worship icons.)
