1) In our non-partisan Get Out the Vote effort, we are reaching out to 15,000 people to help them figure out how to vote and then collecting their names and addresses in order to check the voting records after the election to make sure their votes were counted. 2) Our Community Health Volunteers project has 46 of our members calling COVID-positive people referred to us by the Milwaukee Health Department. The phone calls are made each day for 10 days to people who are recovering at home and monitoring their health condition. We have helped over 250 people to date.
