Yates to begin top administration post on January 1, 2018



The Presbytery of Milwaukee has elected Rachel Yates as Presbytery Executive. In this capacity, she will be responsible for hiring, developing and managing staff, leading strategy for leadership development, building bridges internally and externally, encouraging risk-taking and innovation, among other responsibilities.

Yates had been Associate Director for Program at the Presbyterian Mission Agency in Louisville. She also served as the denomination's West Region Church Support Associate. Previous to that, she spent 23 years at the law firm of Holland & Hart in Denver, Colorado, the last 13 years as a partner. Yates has a bachelor of arts in religious studies from Stanford University and a juris doctorate from the

Boston University School of Law.
